Augmented CB0411/415 during the war work 12hrs on 12hrs off
To maintain Hospital & keep in working order. Used a driver for Exped. Med
Transfer of Med VAC patients, Litter bearing, Shotgun Security
Transported water to the front line troops voluntarily during
the war.

Designed & Installed the Electrical & Plumbing Equipment
for the new galley.

Developed an Inspection Plan for Fleet Hospitals to help
eliminate any problems that may shut the hospital down.

Designed & Built a Cook Room for Fleet Hospital which may
become the standard in future hospitals.

Assisted CB0411/415 in the Re-deployment of Fleet Hospital
5. Packed & Staged the hospital on the port ready for shipment.

Volunteered many off-duty hours to assist FH-5
medical team transport patients to the airport.

Assisted in the delivery of 30,000 gallons of water/day &
1700 gals of fuel per day.

Because of our civilian experience we diagnosed a problem with
a Cummins Diesel Engine at Fleet Hospital 15 which saved them
a few thousand dollars in engine repairs & many lost hours of camp
down time.

Took over the transportation of raw and disposal of
raw sewage, ~~and~~ trash & medical waste when the
Saudi nationalists abandoned their post during ~~the~~
